Measuring Safety Culture

Measuring safety culture through a quantifiable survey tool provides tangible indicators of the current status of safety. When conducted at a trade level, it allows companies to benchmark against industry norms. This data allows organizations to implement improvements and measure progress over time. Measuring safety culture provides member organizations with specific data on employee safety perceptions.

About the Survey

The safety culture survey is administered according to an established survey approach developed in 2013 by INGAA in collaboration with world-renowned experts. The 84-question survey has been used by all types of organizations, including gas utilities, gas and liquid transmission pipeline companies and contractors/service providers. Over 100,000 employees have participated in the survey over the past decade. NGA conducted the 1st and largest LDC-focused safety culture assessment in 2021-2022. The initial assessment results were insightful as we integrated learnings into our PSMS Collaborative framework.

Operators and Contractors

This survey is open to all LDCs and distribution contractors. For LDCs with both gas and electric operations, it can be extended to both groups and is applicable to all employees within the organization.

Participation Benefits

Participating member companies will be provided access to a robust digital dashboard to analyze their survey results and filter by various organizational, demographic attributes, and historical trends. The dashboard allows participants to easily compare their company's results to an overall NGA pipeline norm. Based on the participation, we will create custom benchmarks, such as breakouts for small, medium, and large organizations as well as dual utilities.
