NGA is pleased to bring the Pipeline Safety Regulation Workshop (Part 192) Program to you this fall. This 3-day in-person learning opportunity allows you to advance your knowledge of pipeline safety regulations applied to your operations while networking and sharing experiences with your peers.

The course provides a review and practical application of federal regulations in 49 CFR Parts 191 and 192 that apply to distribution and transmission piping systems, taking students through a "what, why & how" intent-based approach to federal pipeline safety regulations.

The class will be held at the UGI Learning Center in Reading, PA

- **Day 1: Tuesday, October 7th 8am-5pm**
- **Day 2: Wednesday, October 8th 8am-5pm**
- **Day 3: Thursday, October 9th 8am- 12pm**

This is an intense workshop learning experience which will include homework in the evening and a knowledge check at the end of day 3. *Classroom discussions will be re-enforced through practical learning lab discussions at UGI's state-of-the-art Learning Center Facility.*
